

Georgetown Square Pool Rules

Effective 05/2018

I. Schedule

- A. The pool is open approximately from Memorial Day through Labor Day
- B. Pool Hours are 10:00 am to 9:00 pm daily
- C. The pool may be closed due to inclement weather or maintenance

II. Access

- A. A key is needed to access the pool.
 - 1. One key per unit may be obtained from Rachel Paryz, unit 3336A
 - 2. Keys require a \$10 refundable deposit
 - 3. Keys are not to be duplicated
- B. Only owners, renters and their guests may access the pool or pool area.
 - 1. **Guests must be accompanied** by the owner or renter at all times
 - 2. You may have a maximum of 4 guests per unit
 - 3. Groups with **more than 4 guests require a reservation** (see section V)
- C. **Children under 14** years must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older).
- D. **Dogs and pets** are not allowed in the pool area

III. Dress and Health

- A. Proper swim suits must be worn (Cutoff shorts are not allowed).
- B. Children under 3 and **individuals without bowel control** must wear both a swim diaper and outer plastic pants while in the pool. (This is a state law)
- C. **Long hair** (shoulder length or longer) must be tied back, braided or covered by a swim cap. Bobby pins are not allowed. (Hair and bobby pins damage equipment)
- D. **Footwear** must be worn to and from the pool.
- E. Persons with **open wounds** either with or without a covering/bandage are not permitted in the pool. (This is a state law)
- F. Persons with **communicable illnesses** or diseases, or who have had **diarrhea** within the past two weeks are not permitted in the pool. (This is a state law)

IV. Pool Conduct

- A. There is no Lifeguard on duty at Georgetown Square
 - 1. No one may swim alone
 - 2. In case of emergency call 911
 - 3. Do not play with emergency equipment
- B. **No Diving** (the pool is too shallow)
- C. **No Running, or Horseplay** on the pool deck or in the pool (it is slippery when wet)
- D. **No** excessive or prolonged **noise or loud music** in the pool area
- E. **No large floatation devices** (swim noodles, and life vests are permitted)

V. Reservations

- A. Reservations for the pool area and/or clubhouse are required for groups with more than 4 guests. Reservation fees are \$10 for 0-3 hours and \$5 for each additional hour. Residents using the clubhouse or pool for a gathering without a reservation will be fined \$25.
 - 1. Visit www.gtownhoa.com for reservations
 - 2. Reservations are first come first served
 - 3. Reservation fees are **non-refundable**
 - 4. **Cleanup** is the responsibility of the reserving resident

NOTE: All residents have access to the pool and restrooms during your reservation

VI. Food and Drink

- A. Food and drink are not allowed in the pool or on the pool deck (concrete around pool)
- B. **Smoking** is not allowed in the enclosed pool area
- C. **Alcoholic beverages** are not allowed in the enclosed pool area
- D. **Glass** containers are not allowed in the enclosed pool area
